



DUBOIS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

Dubois will be awarding several scholarships, the quantity and values of which will be determined by the Board of Directors and the Scholarship Committee.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The applicant must have permanent residence within the Dubois serving area.
2. The applicant must be a subscriber of Dubois or the child or dependent of a subscriber.
3. The applicant must be a graduating high school senior entering his or her freshman year at an accredited junior college or an accredited college or university as a full-time (12 credit minimum) student. Recipients are limited to one scholarship and may not apply for a second award.
4. The applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher.

EACH APPLICANT MUST SUBMIT:

1. The application cover sheet, as provided by the Dubois office. The signature of the applicant is required for the application to be considered.
2. A list of honors, extracurricular activities, community activities, work experience and other interests and hobbies must be included with the application.
3. An original, signed, formal letter written by the applicant, limited to 300 words or less, stating reasons for desiring this award, educational goals, and other personal and family background information the applicant believes relevant. Please type.
4. A copy of applicant's transcript. Transcripts are to be provided from all high schools attended. Transcripts are to include SAT and/or ACT scores.
5. Each applicant must enclose three letters of recommendation.
 - a. One letter from a current or former employer. If this is not possible, then provide one from a local business person or professional person.
 - b. One letter from a faculty member (teacher).
 - c. One letter from a local resident, (friend or neighbor, but not another faculty member).
6. Applications must be submitted to Dubois Telephone Exchange, Inc., Attention: Scholarship Committee, PO Box 246, Dubois, WY 82513, no later than April 1st. Postmark date will not be taken into consideration.

If the applicant fails to follow the instructions and complete the requirements as outlined, the application will be disqualified. If the applicant has any questions about these requirements or instructions, he or she should contact Dubois at [307] 455-2341.

A scholarship letter announcing the award will be presented to recipients in May, in time for recognition during graduation ceremonies. Scholarship funds will be disbursed when proof of enrollment in a college or university is received by the scholarship committee at Dubois. Proof of enrollment may be fulfilled by presenting a letter of admission and the list of course assignments received by the student upon registration. Once proof of enrollment is received, one-half of the monies will be sent directly to the student for the fall semester. Proof of enrollment information for the fall semester must be received by October 15th, 2020 or the scholarship will be forfeited.

The recipient must maintain a 2.0 GPA or better to receive the second half of the scholarship award. Once verification of fall semester grades and registration for the spring semester have been received by the Scholarship Committee, the remaining monies will be sent to the student. If the scholarship is not claimed by March 1st, 2020 the money will be forfeited.
