Scholarship Requirements

DEADLINE MARCH 26, 2021

The objective of the Range Worland Scholarship is to assist individuals who desire to further his/her education through an accredited junior college, technical school, four-year college or university. Range Worland will offer up to four (4) \$1,000 scholarships to qualified students.

SELECTION FACTORS:

- Applicant has grades from high school and/or continuing college/technical school grades.
- Applicant demonstrates community involvement, extracurricular activities and/or employment. Exhibits leadership qualities.
- Applicant demonstrates that their education/activities facilitate a stated educational goal.
- Applicant has a financial need for the scholarship.
- Overall presentation of material.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Applicants must be a customer, a customer's dependent or a dependent of a Range Worland employee and must state either their account phone number or account number.
- Applicants should be a graduating senior or have graduated from an accredited public, parochial or private high school.
- Applicants must be entering or be enrolled in an accredited junior college, technical school, four-year college or university.

PROCEDURE:

- Applications must be complete, signed, and submitted to Range, Attn: Scholarship Committee, PO Box 506, Worland, WY 82401 and postmarked no later than March 26, 2021.
- Provide a copy of current transcript with cumulative grade point average and SAT/ACT scores, if available, or equivalent college or trade school transcript.
- Provide a Resume which includes Awards, Honors, Activities, Employment, Community Service, etc.
- Provide a one-page essay on the following: 1) Who or what has inspired or influenced you to select your career choice? 2) What have you done to prepare in order to achieve your career goals?
- Complete the Financial Statement to help the Scholarship Committee determine your financial need.
- Provide no more than one (1) letter of recommendation.

If the applicant fails to follow the instructions and complete the requirements as outlined, the application will be disqualified. If the applicant has any questions about these requirements or instructions, he or she should contact the Range Worland office at 307-347-7020.
